INTEGRA REPORT/FINANCIALS

Cindyrae Mehler reported the financial standing through 01-31-21, reflecting the following: Peoples Bank operating account balance \$131,194.65, Heritage Bank operating account balance [laundry income] \$15,699.42, Petty Cash of \$165.34; Edward Jones Reserve account of \$433,004.25, and WECU Activity account of \$2,530.60 – for a total bank of \$582,594.26. INTEGRA Management continues to stay in close contact with the units out of compliance in the Park and all Owners are making an effort to come into compliance.

- ▶ ARCHITECTURAL. Henry Hays reports since 01-01-21, seven (7) Architectural requests have been received and all have been approved.
- ▶ ACTIVITIES. No report. COVID restrictions / activities in the Park will resume when the Governor lifts meeting restrictions.
- ► GROUNDS & MAINTENANCE. Maintenance Report attached.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Log scheduled maintenance resealing: Inspection and Bid scheduled for 02-23-21 by Jeff Kyger with NW Log Home Care.

Pond dredge plan: This will be completed in August 2021.

Doors software upgrade: Don Schleuse and INTEGRA are working together with vendors to seek upgraded system information for the main entry gate and building doors as a capitol project for the future.

North berm split rail fence: Park maintenance staff continue to remove and dispose of the rotten fencing in this area. We anticipate to have this project done by the end of Spring - weather permitting.

Spring Dumpster: The Spring Dumpster will be brought in on 05-21-21 and will leave on 05-31-21.

Reserve Study [30 year Association Plan]: The Board uses the Reserve Study as guidance to review capital projects as they come up and obtains Bids on an as needed basis.

The next Board Meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at 9:00 am – contingent on the Governor's COVID meeting restrictions in place at that time / may be an open meeting [if allowed].

Ongoing monitoring of the compactor.

- . Ongoing monitoring of pool (adding one gallon of chlorine ones a month); pool was winterized. Hot tub (running pumps continually due to really cold temperatures).
 - 3. Repair of hot tub cover (in process).
- Ongoing monitoring of retention pond due to high volumes of rain, clearing cut branches from drain.
 - Irrigation system winterized, one pipe broke during the process and was fixed next day.
- Dumpster camera malfunctioning, several visits from Security solutions (camera replaced).
- Lawn care equipment sent for service (zero turn mower, self propel mower, leaf vacuum, backpack blower, two weed eaters and one edger).
- Annual alarm testing (Guardian Security) November. Two weeks later they replaced a dozen of alarm sensors due to a recall
- New gym equipment installed (fitness gear and training).
 New Battery and cable installed in Truck.
- 11. Two washing machines fixed (two new transmissions and two new clutches, one tub replaced).

12. Monthly bait stations and three visits to spray around buildings (environmental pest control).

13. Barron Heating annual service (October).

14. Furnace motor in club house replaced,

 New water pump for maintenance truck, additives and light bulb for license plate.
