OLD BUSINESS

- 1. Minutes from 12-2-2023 were read and approved.
- 2. Treasurer's Report: the WECU checking account current balance is \$2675.32.
- 3. Rental: February 3
- 4. Friday Potlucks are scheduled for: January 12 and 26; February 9 and 23
- 5. Reports on Special Events: Caroling in the Clubhouse, December 6 (Patricia Kazarow, organizer): a somewhat smaller, but very enthusiastic audience this year; almost all of the 25 carols in the Latitude 49 Christmas Carol Sing-Along handout were sung; hand held jingle bells were added this year and were joyfully rung throughout this Special Event; attendees stayed an extra hour visiting and enjoying the excellent choice of Christmas cookies, treats and fruit as well as coffee, tea, hot apple cider and hot chocolate; attendance may have been affected by the change of date...reconsider putting out a Special Events seasonal flyer for Fall/Winter since so few were picked up Christmas Potluck, December 9 (Ann Archer, Margarete Dittmann and Helen Svien, organizers): more than forty attendees for this Special Event; Patricia performed an hour of Christmas music on her keyboard while appetizers were enjoyed; the sign-up sheet in the Mail Room helped to precipitate the wide variety of dishes that were brought; those who were there thought that it was one of the best Christmas Potlucks they had attended.

Updates on Special Event: **Undecorate the Commons**, **January 6** (Ann Archer and Margarete Dittmann, organizers): because of the prediction of inclement weather, the maintenance staff took down the outside Commons decorations on Wednesday of this week; Theresa and Helen got a head start with taking down the inside Commons decorations on that day as well; Carol will check Christmas decorations for items that need to be discarded as well as refresh all of the wreaths with new materials; a group that she has organized will assist in this special work.
